

AE automatics

- ▶ built-in control cabinet
- ▶ easy to manage using the keys and switches on the control panel
- ▶ the automatics allows manual operation and automatic operation mode
- ▶ the LED indicators above the keys inform the user about the operation momentarily in progress

In the **manual mode** the user starts and ends a particular operation by depressing a button.



drum rotation



pressing, the compressor switch-on, pressure increase



vacuuming, the vacuum pump switch-on, pressure decrease



stop action (interruption of the program, end of drum rotation...)

In the **automatic mode** the user can choose between five standard pressing programs. The incorporated programs result from many years of professional experience and are adjusted to different types of grapes. The programs are factory preset.

PRG 1	soft pressing, pressing of red grapes and fermented dregs
PRG 2	pressing of integral grapes
PRG 3	easy pressing dregs
PRG 4	hard pressing dregs
PRG 5	supplement pressing

AV automatics

- ▶ built-in control cabinet

- ▶ messages of the entered data and later the course of the program are shown on the digital display

Keyboard

- ▶ **numeric keys from 0 to 9** are used for program selection and entering of new parameter values,
- ▶ **yellow symbols** on the keys indicate functions in manual mode,
- ▶ **white symbols** on the keys indicate functions in automatic mode; parameter input, confirmation, recall of the entered data; function keys.



manual operation

In the manual mode the user starts and ends a particular operation by depressing a corresponding key. Only the keys with yellow symbols are valid. Messages about the operation momentarily in progress are displayed on the digital display.

A**automatic operation**

In the automatic mode the user can choose between ten pressing programmes, which are adjusted, observing professional experience, to different grape types. The pressing parameters can be changed and adapted also during the pressing process.

Programms are identified by the numeric keys on the keyboard:

- 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 – standard pressing programmes
- 6, 7, 8 – sequential programmes
- 9 – a programme specifically adjusted to the pressing of ice grapes

AVk automatics

- the command panel is connected to the press through a cable with connector; in this way, the user can freely choose its location on the press or near the press
- the automatics allows manual operation and automatic operation mode
- the user enters data through a keyboard
- messages of the entered data and later the course of the program are shown on the digital display

Keyboard

- **numeric keys from 0 to 9** are used for programm selection and entering of new parameter values,
- **yellow symbols** on the keys indicate functions in manual mode,
- **white symbols** on the keys indicate functions in automatic mode; parameter input, confirmation, recall of the entered dat; function keys.

M**manual operation**

In the manual mode the user starts and ends a particular operation by depressing a corresponding key. Only the keys with yellow symbols are valid. Messages about the operation momentarily in progress are displayed on the digital display.

A**automatic operation**
